9- Eye condition / New glasses:

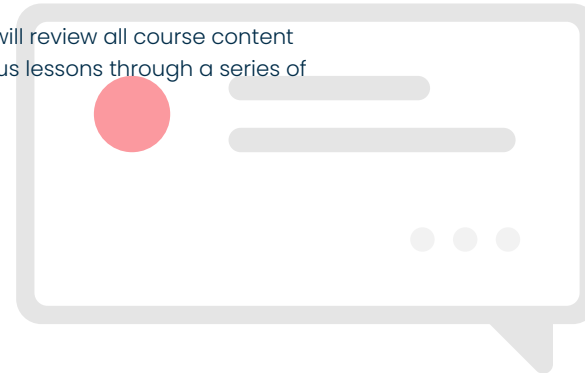
-In this lesson students will develop their understanding and comprehension by listening and following along to a typical situation with a patient seeing an optician for an eye exam.
